

To70 completed SESAR Validation observation project to EUROCONTROL

In May 2015 to70 was awarded a contract from EUROCONTROL Experimental Centre in Bretigny, for the role of support to SESAR validation observations.

Project leader Selma Piric together with Airport Collaboration Decision Making (CDM) expert Eugène Tuinstra visited various experiments regarding Airport Operations Management (AOM), Airport Operations Centre (APOC), and the User Driven Priority Process (UDPP).



Their findings contributed to the elaboration of the final set of SESAR documentation relating to airport operations management as part of the 'SESAR Solution' approach.

In December 2016 the project was completed to the satisfaction of EUROCONTROL. Mr. Alan Marsden commented that 'having To70 experts participate in the various validation exercises was a factor in ensuring the good quality of the final SESAR deliverables'.
