
## Schiphol becomes CDM Airport through NMOC DPI connection

16 May 2018 Amsterdam Airport Schiphol has achieved the status of CDM Airport, by connecting to EUROCONTROL Network Manager Operations Centre (NMOC).

Departure Planning Information (DPI) messages are sent via B2B web service of EUROCONTROL to the Enhanced Tactical Flow Management System (ETFMS) in NMOC.

To70 played a major role in that achievement through Eugène Tuinstra together with Karin Elbers as project leaders CDM@AMS and LVNL, as well as operations data analysis by Ruud van Gils.

The CDM@AMS program is a joint effort by stakeholders KLM, LVNL and AAS for the implementation of Airport CDM at Schiphol airport. The NMOC integration is the last phase of the program, bringing more efficiency in departure planning through enhanced predictability.
