



To70 awarded Project Leader role in CDM@AMS program

In May 2016 to70 was awarded a contract from Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AAS), for the role of Project Leader in the CDM@AMS program.

Eugène Tuinstra has been appointed as project leader in a contract for the remainder of 2016. His role will be to operate under the CDM@AMS program, leading a team of experts preparing for integration to the Network Manager Operations Centre (NMOC) in EUROCONTROL.

The CDM@AMS program is a joint effort by stakeholders KLM, LVNL and AAS for the implementation of Airport CDM at Schiphol airport. The NMOC integration is the last phase of the program. Airport CDM is already operating locally and generating benefits for the stakeholders.
